

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

masunt Compartment safe (all models)

The product may only be used for its intended purpose. The end user may not make any changes or tamper with the electronics or hardware.

The product must be mounted on a stable wall or other suitable location that can withstand the loads.

The safe may only be connected to the power supply by qualified personnel (electricians).

Please be sure to turn off the power before doing any work inside the case.

Make sure the safe and all connected cables are protected from water, moisture or other liquids to minimize the risk of short circuit or electric shock.

Regularly check all cables and connectors for damage. Defective cables and connections must be replaced immediately by qualified personnel to avoid the risk of fire or electric shock.

To prevent overloading of the wiring, which could result in fire or electric shock hazards, do not connect the safe to overloaded power sources.

Make sure that the safe is connected to a power outlet with an easily accessible emergency shutdown function to allow for quick disconnection from the power supply in the event of an emergency.

In case of an electrical fire, keep a suitable fire extinguisher near the safe.

The safe should be installed out of the reach of children. The power connection may only be handled by adults or trained personnel.

Access codes must always be kept safe and should only be made available to authorized persons to avoid misuse.
